The United States Martial Arts Hall of Fame (USMAHOF) is honored to announce Master Victor Teran, an 8th degree black belt in the Art of Taekwon-Do, has been selected for induction into our prestigious Hall of Fame. The Inductee Class of 2024 will be formally recognized and honored at a black-tie banquet and ceremony, to be held on Saturday, July 20, 2024, at The Orleans Hotel & Casino in Las Vegas, NV.

Master Teran has previously partnered with Play4Autism Foundation in New Jersey to provide training to children with autism spectrum disorder, and recently partnered with the "Dear Jack Foundation" in Colorado, who provides programs to adolescent and young adult cancer patients, survivors, and family. "This is a special project, because it is all about giving back to our community; in the belief that the opportunity to learn martial arts should be available to everyone, no matter their condition, setbacks, or limitations".
